


Building improvements

Our pupils have been enjoying the new work space. They are currently researching design ideas for the walls in the new classroom.













Jenna and Katie from the Rise Up team gave an interactive presentation to pupils at Educ8 Liverpool on alcohol and drugs in heavy use by teenagers in the local area. The program included a very special emphasis on Ketamine, but also included significant discussion of MDMA/ecstasy, cocaine cannabis and the effects of aerosols and gases such as nitric oxide. Jenna & Katie were keen to emphasize the confidential/non abstinence/nonjudgmental nature of their team in treating young adults for substance misuse without the fear of intervention by police. Pupils actively took the opportunity to ask questions and learn about how to access free treatment in their community.
